ASSOCIATE OR FULL PROFESSOR
Interdisciplinary Studies

The Department of Interdisciplinary Learning and Teaching in the College of Education and Human Development at the University of Texas at San Antonio (coe.hd.utsa.edu), a recognized, Hispanic-serving institution, invites applications for one tenured position for Interdisciplinary Studies at the associate or full professor level beginning Fall 2008.

Responsibilities include teaching both graduate and undergraduate courses that are offered either at the UTSA downtown campus, the 1604 campus, on public school campuses, and occasionally at night; serving on thesis and doctoral committees; advising and supervising students in field placements; conducting an active program of research; seeking grant funding; and providing service to the department, college, university, and community constituencies.

Required Qualifications: (1) earned doctorate with an emphasis in interdisciplinary studies or a related degree that reflects educational theory and theoretical expertise in one or more disciplines; (2) teaching and supervising experience; (3) understanding of interdisciplinary methodologies, techniques, and theories, as well as thematic curricular and program design; and (4) evidence of research and publication record commensurate with position.

Preferred Qualifications: (1) evidence of teaching experience at the elementary and/or secondary level in a state-accredited school; (2) demonstrated experience in interdisciplinary studies; (3) ability to work collaboratively with faculty and administrators from different disciplines and colleges; (4) experience with and knowledge about the use of technology to support teaching and learning; (5) ability to seek and procure grants and external funding; (6) experience related to culturally or linguistically diverse populations; and (7) experience in leadership roles.

Initial Screening: Qualified candidates must submit an application letter that addresses the required and preferred qualifications; current curriculum vitae; 1-2 page description of research agenda; 3-5 recent published, peer-reviewed articles; copies of official transcripts; names, addresses, email addresses, and telephone numbers of three references. The review of applications will begin immediately and will continue until the position is filled.
